

## General Landscaping Information

For residents who have received a notice that states they are in need of replacing or installing plants or trees in their yards, the teams at Rancho Sahuarita and Associa Arizona have allowed a period of **6 months (or until November 2016)** for those residents to do so before a violation is processed.

Helpful tips:

- Consult the **Design Guidelines** provided on this site before contemplating landscape changes.  
Specially reference
  - o Section 3.18 references the **Minimum Landscaping Requirements** to determine the front and backyard landscaping requirements
  - o Section 3.8 references other **Yardscaping** rules and regulations which outline yard improvements which may require approval from the Architectural Review Committee.
  
- Be sure your plant or tree choice is in compliance with the **approved and prohibited plant** list provided on this site.
  
- If there is no landscaping in your yard, a landscaping plan must be submitted and approved prior to planting. Please fill out an **Architectural Review Form** and submit it with landscape plan to ensure your plants are in line with the design guidelines.
