Rules & Regulations

1. All boats/rafts must be homemade
2. All boats/rafts must be made in the spirit of the contest – don't just tape bottles to a raft, really put thought into your boat/raft
3. No commercially manufactured boats/rafts
4. No boat/raft can be made from a commercial or manufacturing kit
5. The following materials to make the boats/rafts are not allowed
 - a. Cardboard
 - b. Rubber (Except inner tubes)
 - c. Glass
 - d. Metal (Except for metal fasteners and sheet metal)
 - e. Plastic Sheeting

All items utilized to construct the boat/raft need to be of a buoyant material to avoid littering the lake bottom should the vessel break apart during the race. Exceptions to this rule would include items such as rope/twine and duct tape that could be used to secure individual components together.

6. All boats/rafts utilizing Styrofoam, must have the Styrofoam completely enclosed to avoid littering in the lake
7. Crew members must be able to carry their boat/raft from their vehicle to the lake
8. There has to be at least two crew members on the boat/raft
9. All crew members must be human (no pets allowed)
10. All boats/rafts must be self-propelled (i.e., oars, paddlewheels, sails, etc.)
 - a. No poles of any kind will be allowed to push the watercraft from the bottom of the lake.
11. The deck must be capable of supporting the weight of the crew
12. At least one crew member must have been responsible for the construction of the homemade boat/raft
13. One crew member must be at least 16 years old or older
14. All crew members must provide their own lifejacket and wear in while in the lake (no lifejackets will be provided)
15. Prior to race, no contestant will touch or move any other contestant's boat/raft without permission
16. Racers may not hinder another racer or boat in any way. No boat-to-boat or person-to-person contact will be allowed. Violation of this rule may result in disqualification. Final decision to be made by race committee
17. Squirt guns are not only allowed, but encouraged!!! (but water balloons are prohibited)
18. To win the race, 65% of the boat/raft and all crew members must make it to the finish line
19. Final decision on if the boat/raft is acceptable is up to the WFYB committee
